Don't Kill Your Bugs!

Your aerobic treatment plant is a "living" machine that houses a micro-organism "bug colony" which consumes organic waste. These micro-organisms require oxygen and appropriate "food" (organic waste devoid of toxins) to survive.

Do's

- Garbage disposals should be used sparingly.
- Laundry loads must be spread out over the week.Recommend 2 per day max.
- Use laundry detergent that are lowsudsing, low in phosphates and biodegradable.
- Use fabric softeners sheets instead of liquid softener.
- Use cleaning products that are nonchlorine, non-toxic, non-corrosive, and biodegradable.

Warning Signs of Aerobic System Problems

- · Alarms or lights going off
- · Any changes in the system's normal operating sound
- Any changes in the normal color of the wastewater in the aeration chamber(for example, if the color is grayish brown rather than chocolate brown, this can sometimes indicate problems)
- · Excessive solids, foam, or scum in the unit
- · Plumbing backups
- · Sewage odors in the house or yard
- Odor or sewer smell during system spray(sprinklers going off)

Aerobic System Do's & Dont's

Don'ts

Do not dispose of grease, fats or oils in drains.

Do not dispose of pesticides, herbicides or other toxins.

Do not dispose of paints, household chemicals, automobile fluids into the system.

Do not dispose of non-biodegradable items such as cigarette butts, disposable diapers, feminine hygeine products, condoms, hair, coffee grounds, paper towels, bandages, etc.

Do not use chemical chemical drain cleaners or additives like "Rid-X" or similar products.

Do not dispose of alcoholic beverages or home brewery waste.

Do not dispose of strong disinfectants or bleaches, such as "Clorox", "Lysol", or "Pine-Sol".

Do not use automatic toilet bowl cleaning dispensers such as "Tidy Bowl".

Do not dispose of medicines into the system.

Do not allow anyone to drive over or park on any part of your system.

Do not connect other water sources to the system.

Do not attempt to clean or perform maintenance on any sealed system components.

Do not make unauthorized repairs or changes to the system.
